- Through its groundbreaking website [Pištaljka](#) (The Whistle), Eutopia Association engages in investigative journalism and whistleblowing advocacy.
- Since 2010, when it was launched, Pištaljka has published more than 500 stories, including articles on high-level corruption and stories about whistleblowers.
- Using the Global Compact network in Serbia, Eutopia presented its work on anti-corruption to members of the network and took active part in all anti-corruption activities of the network.
- From April 2014, Eutopia has been counselling whistleblowers and potential whistleblowers through its Whistleblowing Helpline. Eutopia representatives and two whistleblowers were part of the working group that drafted Serbia's Whistleblower Protection Law, one of the best such laws in the world according to renowned international experts.
